

PRADHAN MANTRI MATRU VANDANA YOJANA (PMMVY)

What is PRADHAN MANTRI MATRU VANDANA YOJANA?

Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) is a conditional Maternity Benefit Program of the Government of India implemented by the Ministry of Women and Child Development using the platform of the Anganwadi services.

The objectives of PMMVY are:

- Providing partial financial support for pregnant and lactating mothers to improve the health and nutrition during pregnancy and after delivery as well as compensation for wage loss, if any.
- 2. The scheme also seeks to promote positive behavioral change towards girl child by providing additional cash incentive for the second child, if that is a girl child.

Who can apply?

▶ The benefit is given for the **first two live births**, **provided the second child is a girl**, excluding Pregnant Women & Lactating Mothers who are in regular employment with the central or State Government or Public sector Undertakings or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law. A beneficiary is eligible to register in PMMVY till 270 (9 months) days from childbirth.

Criteria List:

- 1. Women belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes.
- 2. Women who are partially (40%) or fully disabled (Divyang Jan).
- 3. Women holder of BPL/ National Food Security Act 2013 Ration cards.
- 4. Women beneficiaries under Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana (PMJAY) under Ayushman Bharat.
- 5. Women holding E-shram Card.
- 6. Women farmers who are beneficiaries under KisanSamman Nidhi.
- 7. Women holding MGNREGA Job Card.
- 8. Women whose net family income is less then Rs.8 Lakh per annum.
- 9. Pregnant and Lactating AWWs/AWHs/ASHAs.
- 10. Any other category as may be prescribed by the Central Government.

Benefits under PMMVY:

All eligible beneficiaries who have applied and comply with the conditionalities will receive cash incentives of ₹5000/- in two instalments and additional cash incentive of ₹6000/- for second child, if that is a girl child through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) to their individual bank accounts.

Conditions and installments for 1st child:

Installments	Conditions			
First Installment	On Registration of pregnancy and at least one Ante-Natal Checkup within 6 months from Last Menstrual Period (LMP) date at the Anganwadi Centre (AWC) or approved Health Facilities.	₹ 3,000/-		
Second Installment	 i. Child Birth is registered ii. Child has received first cycle of BCG, OPV, DPT and Hepatitis - B or its equivalent/substitute 	₹2,000/-		

Benefits for Pregnant Woman & Lactating Mothers (PW&LM) for the Second child will be done in one installment after the child is born; however, pregnancy has to be registered during pregnancy.

Documents and Details required:

- 1. Aadhaar card of the beneficiary with Date of Birth.
- 2. Address and Phone number.
- 3. Bank account details of the beneficiary may not be submitted but the applicant must have an Aadhaar seeded bank Account.
- 4. Mother and Child Protection (MCP) Card (LMP date, Ante-natal and Vaccination records).
- 5. RCH ID/MCP Card number.
- 6. Any one document in support of the criteria list. Eg. ST/SC certificate, Ration card, E-shram card, Ayushmaan Bharat Card etc.

Where do I apply?

- 1. At the nearest Anganwadi Center.
- At the nearest office of the District Programme Officer (DPO) and Child Development Project Officer (CDPO)
- 3. District Hub for Empowerment of Women (DHEW) attached to the Deputy Commissioner's offices in the districts.
- 4. Individual beneficiaries can apply online through Citizen Registration on mobile app or web application @ https://pmmvy.nic.in
